ReConnect China aims to explore the possibilities of collaboration between the EU and China in 4 strategic domains: Science & Technology, Economy & Trade, Domestic Governance and Foreign Policy. The project will raise awareness of EU-China relations among the general public and European youth by utilizing Massive Open Online Courses (MOOC), podcast series and infographics, and disseminate the research findings through policy briefs, research papers, and academic articles. The key objective is to bring together stakeholders and experts in a Europe-China Knowledge Forum to 'translate' the scientific analysis into strategic knowledge and policy impact.


