 Advancing institutional change through Gender Equality Plans

18 months into the project we have established  The Horizon Europe GEP eligibility criterion exerted noticeable impact on the national gender equality activities in R&I,

 Gender Equality Plans are mandatory in most of the European countries/regions but there is a lack of monitoring and evaluation systems,

that at the ERA policy level

- The field of inclusion and intersectionality is at an initial phase of development but there is a lack of a unified understanding of the concepts related to intersectionality and inclusiveness and a lack of intersectional data for R&I,
- Over half of the participating RFOs have adopted specific policies for integrating the gender dimension in the content of research and innovation but there is a lack of clarity regarding the difference between the gender dimension and gender equality considerations,
- Only 2 out of 15 national authorities have a national or regional policy against gender-based violence for RPOs and only 1 RFO has measures targeting applicants.
